
Using eBook databases

# What are ebooks?

- Ebooks are electronic books – they are either digitized versions of printed books or books originally published digitally (i.e. born-digital).
- Touro Libraries provides access to many eBooks that can be read directly from your computer.


What if you want to save or print a PDF copy?
